**For Contractor/Supplier/Vendors**

El Paso County(EPC) is implementing an Environmental Management System (EMS)/ISO14001. The County is committed to the success and sustainability of EMS. Part of that commitment extends to providing information to our strategic contractor/supplier/vendors (CSVs).

**Your Role and Responsibility as a CSV employee or subcontractor in the EPC EMS is to:**

- ◆ *Know our Environmental Policy which embraces our core beliefs of:*

**C**omply with Requirements  
**P**revent Pollution  
**I**mprove Continually

- ◆ *Identify, understand & comply with the environmental requirements of your activities*
  - Maintain control and management over your products, materials and waste materials - including the prompt off-site disposal of all waste materials in accordance with all applicable legal requirements.
  - Do not put any product or waste liquids in drains, sumps or trenches on property controlled by EPC.
  - Obtain all environmental regulatory permits prior to commencing your activities on any EPC property to which you have been assigned.
- ◆ *Conduct appropriate training*
  - Ensure employees working on EPC properties and/or projects are appropriately trained on the management of materials and wastes.
- ◆ *Know the emergency procedures of the EPC property you are working on.*
- ◆ *Report chemical spills, caused by your personnel or observed by your personnel as required by the emergency response plan or as directed by your County point of contact!*
